Who should attend: Early childhood teachers who have previously trained with the School Literacy and Culture Project and currently use story dictation in their classrooms

How can teachers become more intentional in their use of individual dictation and dramatization in their classrooms? During this two-day seminar, participants will:

- Review current research as it pertains to the dictation/dramatization of children's stories
- Look closely at how teacher-student interaction impacts children's story dictation
- Learn ways to enhance ESL students' success with both dictation and dramatization
- Develop questioning skills to help individualize each child's dictation experience and help children get the most out of these one-on-one interactions
- Analyze actual story dictation transcripts
- Participate in small group discussions of the cognitive and socio-emotional goals of the story dictation process
- Examine the important role of dictation/dramatization in ongoing, dynamic assessment

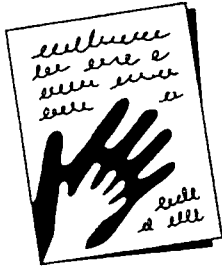
